

# Installation of Save Wizard Beta

The new Beta client is uses the mono platform to achieve greater platform independence. If you are using a windows platform, windows 7 or later you might be better off using the win32 build which is more stable than the Mono version available [here](#). The Mono version however will ultimately replace the win32 version and so may have newer features.

## Installation

Currently there is no installer and the Save Wizard client is stored in a ZIP archive so you will need to download and extract it manually. We hope to create platform specific installers soon.

### Linux Ubuntu and other Debian derivatives

Go to <https://www.mono-project.com/download/stable/#download-lin> and download and install the latest stable version. Notice that Save Wizard requires a fairly recent Mono as previous versions had critical bugs so we recommend not installing using your usual repository at this point.

On Ubuntu and other debian derivatives you will also need to install the following

```
sudo apt-get install libmono-microsoft-visualbasic10.0-cil
```

First Download and extract the ZIP file to a folder of your choosing.

Ensure you have the USB drive from your PS4 inserted before launching the SaveWizard Software. Currently a USB path is required.

Find the SaveWizard.exe file and launch using mono. Typically that can be executed with a right click on the file and Open with "Mono Runtime (terminal)". You can also run save wizard from the command line from a bash shell as follows.

```
mono SaveWizard.exe
```

### Windows

Windows should contain the latest Mono.

Download the latest version of SaveWizard and extract the contents of the zip to a folder.

Run the SaveWizard.exe file by double clicking.

## **OS X**

Go to <https://www.mono-project.com/download/stable/#download-lin> and download and install the latest stable version. Notice that Save Wizard requires a fairly recent Mono as previous versions had critical bugs so we recommend not installing using your usual repository at this point.

Extract the contents of the zip file and run a Bash prompt

```
mono --arch=32 SaveWizard.exe
```
